BLACKOUT POETRY GUIDE:



- 1) START BY SKIMMING YOUR PAGE OF WORDS. DON'T READ TOO CAREFULLY
- 2) GO THROUGH AND LIGHTLY CIRCLE THE WORDS OR PHRASES YOU MIGHT WANT TO USE. GRAB A BLANK PIECE OF PAPER AND WRITE THEM DOWN IN ORDER, THEN READ THROUGH THEM. CROSS OUT WORDS YOU DON'T WANT. IF YOU NEED A FEW CONNECTING WORDS (LIKE, A, THE, IT, ETC.) THEN DIVE BACK IN AND SEE IF YOU CAN FIND THEM BETWEEN WORDS YOU WANT TO CONNECT
 - 3) GO BACK THROUGH YOUR POEM AND BOLDY BOX THE WORDS YOU ARE KEEPING (ERASE ANY CIRCLES AROUND WORDS YOU DON'T WANT)
- 4) READ THROUGH YOUR FINAL POEM. SKETCH IN SOME DOODLES OR SYMBOLS ON THE PAGE THAT RELATE TO THE THEME OF YOUR POEM. THEN START BLACKENING. YOU CAN USE A SHARPIE, PENCIL, PEN, OR MARKERS. JUST MAKE SURE TO BLOCK OUT EVERYTHING THAT IS NOT A WORD IN YOUR POEM OR ON ONE OF YOUR DRAWINGS
